



Abstract submission:

Recommendations to authors

Abstracts shall be submitted via online submission system by December 1, following the online instructions.

Abstracts shall:

- contain a maximum of 300 words
- be written in English
- not contain tables or/and pictures
- be related to the indicated topics
- indicate the preferred kind of presentation (oral/poster/poster with flash presentation)

Please consider also that:

- Errors in the text will not be corrected: the content and literary standard of submitted abstracts is under the author's responsibility
- Authors' names and affiliations will be printed as entered in the abstract submission tool, so please make sure these are correctly entered

The following subdivisions should be identified in the abstract:

- Background & Objectives
- Material & Methods
- Results
- Discussion & Conclusion

Each subdivision has to be written in a separate box during the submission process.



Evaluation criteria

Abstracts will be evaluated both on scientific quality and practical implications of the reported study. In this context, the authors have to be aware that names of commercial products should not be cited more than twice in the abstract including the title of the study. The abstracts should also be presented in a way that strong statements are clearly supported by presented results (e.g. a treatment effect should be supported by significant statistical results). The implication of the research for the daily veterinary practice in the field of porcine health management should also be clearly evidenced.
